Exhibitors Please Note:

- 1 The age of cattle is taken from 1st May each year.
- 2 All animals (including calves at foot) must be NLIS tagged; test negative for Pestivirus; have a completed NVD and Herd Health Statement.
- 3 All handlers are required to have an ASC Risk Acknowledgement Waiver completed.
- 4 Cattle must be at the showground by 9am for registration.
- 5 Cattle must remain at the showground until 3pm.
- 6 Any animal entered in led classes which are not thoroughly tractable to lead, will not be admitted to the ground.
- 7 All Bulls, 9 months and over, must have a nose clip or ring, and over 12 months, a nose ring.
- 8 All Females, 9 months and over, must be exhibited with a nose clip.
- 9 All animals to be secured with appropriate halter and neck strap while stalled.
- 10 Calves at foot - calves must be under 9 months of age at 1st May.
- 11 Stud Cattle Entries must be registered with their Breed Society.
- 12 Cattle entered in the Breed section may not be exhibited in the Commercial classes or vice versa.
- 13 No bulls are to be paraded by persons under 18 years in Junior Paraders classes.
- 14 Exhibitors to supply own bedding.
- 15 The decision of the Chief Steward is final. This includes any program changes on the day as required, and the distribution of goods and prizemoney based on entries received.
